educational program. Homeschooled students are permitted to compete as long as they meet all other eligibility requirements.
Youth must attach the appropriate essay (see scholarships page, rule 7).
Youth may enter any or all categories, subject to eligibility.
Candidates MUST have attended at least ONE JrBAA Society Community Education Session in the 12 months prior to submission of the application.
