All nomination statements must be completed and submitted on our website or emailed to info@jrbaa.org no later than July 15th.

Eligibility: Students must meet these criteria to be eligible. Please initial:

- Youth must identify as Black African descent
- Youth must be between 11 -19 years old and in grades 5 - 12 or equivalent.
- Youth must be legal resident of British Columbia, Canada, and enrolled in a BC educational program. Homeschooled students are permitted to compete as long as they meet all other eligibility requirements.
- Youth must attach the appropriate essay (see scholarships page, rule 7).
- Youth may enter any or all categories, subject to eligibility.
- Candidates **MUST** have attended at least ONE JrBAA Society Community Education Session in the 12 months prior to submission of the application.

- A small photograph of the nominee (school photo or other) must be submitted. Maximum size: 2 1/2" x 3 1/2". Photos will be retained and shown in a framed display on the awards night and at subsequent awards.
- Finalists are expected to attend the ceremony-although this is not a criterion for a nomination. Organizers are to be advised if a finalist cannot attend.
- Youth may nominate themselves.
- Please attach the student's most recent report card and any supporting documents relevant to this nomination.
